**Footnotes**

MEGAN'S CRACKER was unhurried early, fanned six wide out of the then was up in the final stride despite being carried out late by SKIP TO SAVANNAH. SKIP TO SAVANNAH was boxed early, angled out three wide to go after the leaders after five furlongs, led inside the final furlong then was caught late after bearing out before being steadied and straightened. RAINBOWS AND ROSES set the pace to mid stretch before hanging late. MS. WOLF was void of speed to the stretch then closed a gap late. STOPYOURTWINNING made an inside middle move, got through inside to loom a threat in the furlong grounds then hung late. CALIBOGUE SOUND chased early, bid through the second turn then gave way. RIZZI GIRL chased early, bid after five furlongs then faltered. WHAT A SWEEP failed to menace. LIGHT THE RIVER was rank early, bid through the second turn then came up empty. LOVER'S VENDETTA failed to menace. RED EYED DOLLY showed little. The portable inner rail was set at zero feet.
