SO SMOOTH stalked the leaders for six furlongs, bid three wide into the stretch then responded to strong handling in the final strides. CLASSIC MOON rushed to the lead early, dueled to the stretch, shook clear then just failed to last. MONT JULEPS vied for the lead to the stretch then slowly weakened. FORBIDDEN DAY passed tiring rivals. NOTASHADOWOFADOUBT chased early, bid into the second turn then flattened out. OBVIOUS REASON raced wide throughout. FIREONTHERANGE weakened gradually. SUPAH SOUP showed little. OYSTER SLEW was through early. SILVER EAGLE trailed.
