HIGH CRY raced well placed inside early, had to wait for racing room in the second turn, found room along the rail to challenge for and gain a clear lead a furlong out then lasted late under pressure. ANOTHER SMOKEY was void of early speed, angled out five wide out of the second turn then closed fast outside late. MY ESTELLE was unhurried early, bid inside in the drive then finished well late. PARIS BY NIGHT stalked the pace early, bid outside the leader leaving the second turn then was outkicked in the crucial stages. JULIET TANGO was well placed but lacked a strong late response. CHLOE CAROL set a moderate pace into the stretch then weakened. SPECIAL JAK was no factor. STAR REWARD was no factor.
