Footnotes

COYOTESHIGHESTCALL was unhurried early, looped rivals while moving quickly to contention outside, dueled through a long drive and was all out to prevail. WAYZATA BAY was void of early speed, fanned seven wide out of the second turn then closed with a rush late to just miss. SHOOT OUT made a middle move then was blocked and lacked clear racing room until the final stages. TONKA BOY stalked the pace for six furlongs, fanned six wide into the stretch then was also outfinished after looking like a threat a furlong out. FOREVER WILD dueled to mid stretch before giving way grudgingly. PYRITE SPRINGS pressed the pace three wide to the stretch then weakened. BROADWAYBUCK failed to menace. CIMARRON'S TIME was no factor. LIVELY EXIT dueled to the stretch then came in during the drive to impede DAN'S SOLDIER while tiring. DAN'S SOLDIER made an inside middle move, was rallying along the rail in the drive when bumped and eliminated by LIVELY EXIT. There was a stewards inquiry conducted in the stretch run but there was no change in the original order of finish.
