SAFETY NET was unhurried early, was blocked behind rivals and forced to wait for clear racing room after five furlongs then finished strong once clear to rally past the leader and be along in time. BAJAN QUEEN dueled from the outset, turned back several bids then weakened in the final sixteenth while best of the rest. SAND DREAM was well placed but failed to respond in the drive. GATOR'S TRACKS stalked the early pace, bid outside through the second turn to mid stretch then weakened late. FRANNY BABIE raced evenly. BIG RED GIRL passed tiring rivals. PAMPAS LASS also turned in an even effort. LEMON PIE showed little. MINIWETA was through after a half. JEWELBERRY stopped.
