**Footnotes**

SUMO raced close up inside early, got through along the rail to gain the lead after five furlongs, drew off to the furlong marker then drifted out badly before before being straightened inside the final furlong to come back on again and prevail late. REMARKABLE STORM was fractious in the gate, raced close up throughout, bid into the stretch then angled inside the winner leaving the furlong grounds when that one drifted wide and drew even for the lead late before hanging. BALLY BUFF was void of early speed, fanned four wide while advancing into the stretch then finished willingly outside but was outkicked late. CALL NINE ONE ONE was well placed but had no rally. GO TEBOW GO set a moderate pace then faded after six furlongs. SON OF TIGER chased then stopped. There was a stewards inquiry and claim of foul by the rider of REMARKABLE STORM against the winner for interference in the stretch but no change was made in the original order of finish.
