MARIEVAL never far back, raced boxed through the second turn, found room when EARLY HATCH BORE OUT to challenge into the stretch then after dueling past mid stretch, shook clear late then held sway late under pressure. ACADEMIC QUEEN was unhurried early, fanned five wide into the stretch then was up for the place late. SAFETY NET also well placed early, bid in company with the winner leaving the second turn but weakened in the final furlong. LOVE BOOT dueled inside to mid stretch then gave way. TIS UNANSWERABLE was no factor. SECRET LIES was hung wide to the second turn then was carried out further when EARLY HATCH bore out, losing all chance. EARLY HATCH rushed up to dispute the early pace, lugged out down the backstretch then bore out badly through the second turn and was not pressed thereafter. The portable inner rail was set out 12 feet.
