PERSONAL GOOD raced boxed inside much of the way, got through along the rail to challenge into the furlong grounds then wore down WILDCAT FORMATION late under strong handling. WILDCAT FORMATION pressed the pace three wide, drove clear into the stretch then continued gamely to late before just getting caught. REGAL ROSETTI was void of early speed, swung six wide out of the turn then finished willingly outside late. SICKY NICKY was hung four wide from the start, bid outside into the stretch but weakened late. STUDLEY was well placed into the stretch but lacked a strong late response. WAIKIKI dueled to the stretch then gave way. THISENEFORROGER was no factor. STORM SLEW vied for the lead to the stretch then was shuffled back while tiring.
