FALLING SKY set a moderate pace early, drifted off the rail a bit in the second turn then came back in passing the quarter pole, shook clear in the furlong grounds then just lasted over DYNAMIC SKY late. DYNAMIC SKY was never far back, bid four wide leaving the second turn, held on well when the winner shook clear then was slowly gaining late while drifting in during the drive. MY NAME IS MICHAEL was void of speed early, settled into the stretch then closed fast late outside. SPEAK LOGISTICS stalked the pace inside, bid inside in the second turn, was in tight quarters and forced to take up passing the quarter pole and failed to fully recover. MIDNITE POPPA closed a gap but too late. DIVINE AMBITION chased early, bid in the second turn then steadied between rivals passing the quarter pole and faded. SILVER DAY failed to menace. LIGHTNING STONE was no factor. BALINO stopped. A claim of foul by the rider of SPEAK LOGISTICS against the winner for interference at the quarter pole was disallowed.
