QUITE A DUDE stalked the leaders early, split rivals into the stretch to challenge then pulled away late under brisk handling. MANEKE also split rivals in the furlong grounds to be up for the place late. ZOELING was in striking distance out of the turn but lacked a strong response in the drive. LOST CAMPER dueled early, shook clear in the turn then weakened in the final furlong. COOPER JUNIOR dueled early then gave way in the drive. BIG TEXAS DADDY failed to menace. FAMILY FOUNDATION was no factor. IRISH ANSWER broke slow. MR. HERMAN was through early. MR. GREEN showed little.
