BATTLE HARDENED stalked the pace inside, angled out four wide out of the second turn to go after the leaders then drove clear leaving the furlong grounds and had enough left late to hold sway. PROSPECTIVE was hung five wide to the second turn, fanned six wide into the stretch then closed fast outside but too late. REVERON raced close up outside early, bid four wide in the second turn, gained a short lead in the drive but hung late. RAVELO'S BOY fanned six wide then was gaining some ground outside late. NECK 'N NECK was void of speed, swung to the far outside in mid stretch then closed a late gap. FOX RULES pressed the pace for six furlongs then gave way. STATE OF PLAY set a moderate pace to the stretch then gave way. BURNING TIME failed to threaten. MOROCCAN BREW was through after a half. HOLY HIGHWAY made an inside middle move then came up empty. ECABRONI was taken up at the break then showed little.
