SPEED RING stalked the pace for five furlongs, bid four wide into the stretch then shook off INDIAN EMPIRE leaving the furlong marker and drew away late. INDIAN EMPIRE dueled with the winner into the final furlong before weakening then saved the place late. SUGAR PEAKS angled out six wide then made up some ground late outside. BEN BEN MECHON dueled between rivals into the stretch then weakened. CALPULLEC passed tiring rivals. BOHICKET dueled to the quarter pole then faded. ADARO was through after a half. GROOM'S SPIRIT was through early. SICCARDI showed little. INVISIBLE GENIUS trailed.
