MALADYSCAT was never far back, made a quick move from between rivals to go after the leaders out of the second turn then after dueling through the furlong grounds, drew clear late under brisk handling. PREMIUM POSITION stalked the leader early, bid after five furlongs to gain a short lead in the drive but hung late while saving the place. NOT MY STYLE broke sharp to set the early pace, resisted well to the late stages then hung. CHULA made an inside middle move, swung outside for the drive then made some gain late. SHRIMP TEMPURA passed tiring rivals. CAGEY MOVE saved ground to the stretch but had no rally. LOST IN THE WEEDS chased for six furlongs then faded. JEN'S TOUR raced evenly. JAZZ FLIGHT showed little. TURBO IDE stopped. The portable inner rail was set at 12 feet.
