MOCK ME NOT pressed the pace three wide early, dueled into the final furlong to gain a clear lead then just lasted laet. KENTA KUN was slow to settle, fanned six wide out of the turn then closed fast late. DALLIANCE was void of speed to the stretch then also closed fast but too late. TWO SAINTS was well placed early, bid into the stretch then was outkicked late. RAGING TRIPP pressed the issue early then gradually weakened. OORAH raced evenly. FAST FASHION was through after a half. GENTLEMAN JOHN dueled into the final furlong then faltered. SERENGETI STORM showed little.
