CAPT. CANDYMAN CAN stalked the pace from the start, bid three wide after five furlongs then wore down the leader late after drifting in slightly leaving the furlong marker. LEGAL MOVE dueled inside, continued gamely in the drive to gain a short lead then just hung. A DIEHL fanned six wide out of the turn then closed a gap but too late. CONCHACER dueled past mid stretch then steadied inside the winner while tiring. LIEUTENANT DAN passed tiring rivals. GOOD LORD steadied after the break, chased to the stretch then weakened. ST. MAXIMUS GATO was through after a half. LET IT ROCK showed little. SEE I A stopped. There was a stewards inquiry and claims of foul by the rider of CONCHACER against the winner for interference in the stretch and by the rider of GOOD LORD against CONCHACER for interference leaving the gate but there was no change made in the original order of finish.
