MILLENNIUM LAKES made a middle move, angled out four wide in the drive then ran down PORCUPINE late. PORCUPINE also made a middle move, angled out three wide to go after the leader into the furlong grounds then drove clear late before being caught on the wire. GO TEBOW GO chased into the stretch then weakened in the drive. WILLIE'S WAY saved ground into the stretch then failed to gain. SPECIAL EXCHANGE set a strong pace past mid stretch then weakened. CUP OF WHYS failed to menace. SPANISH STYLE raced evenly. CANO CODE made a four wide middle move then flattened out. PICAROO was no factor. STACK THE DECK stopped.
