HANDSOME NED stalked the pace inside, angled off the rail to go after the leader leaving the second turn then drew off through the final furlong. TECHNICAL EXPRESS set a moderate pace for six furlongs, resisted to the final furlong but was no match while second best. DIRTKICKER made a middle move, bid into the stretch then flattened out. ALKAZABITO was well placed but had no rally. NOROAMIN passed tiring rivals. SO VERY IRISH chased, bid after five furlongs then faltered. VALANCE raced eight wide in the drive. LAWRENCEBERG was no factor. WEEKEND AT ROMERO showed little. SAM C. was no factor.
