SOURPOWER angled out four wide after five furlongs then outfinished the rest while no match for the winner. TAXICAB looped four wide to move closest to the winner into the stretch then weakened late. HUNGARIAN GENT presed the winner early, remained close up to the final furlong then gave way. THE KEY TO TIME was through after a half. HARDTOBEAT BOB had a wide trip. RED CAPTAIN failed to threaten. CEE T CEE TWO bid five wide through the second turn then came up empty. HEZA HARLEY MAN chased to the second turn then faded. SHOULDABEENAMARINE showed little.
