TODGE allowed to settle, looped up four wide through the second turn, fanned widest into the stretch, then made a steady gain and edged ahead in the final strides. DUBIOUS BACHELOR pushed out at the start, looped to position four wide through the second turn, came three wide to bid, edged ahead late and was outfinished. PLANT CITY RED broke out at the start, rushed up to set the pace on a clear lead, stayed on when challenged through the second turn, came again in the lane and lacked the needed late kick. CHINA HOLIDAY tracked the pace on the inside, came through inside of rivals to edged ahead through the second turn, then weakened in the drive. BARBADA pushed out at the start, looped up three wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch and could not gain. TAP'N MY TOES was no factor. I. E. FLASH stalked the pace on the outside, edged ahead through the second turn, then had no stretch rally.
