GREELEY'S TUNE was reserved for a half, made a strong three wide move to take charge on the turn and edged clear under right hand urging. COWGIRL COFFEE saved ground for five furlongs, steadied while lacking room and altered course to the outside at the quarter pole and rallied belatedly. I'VE GOT GAME raced in midpack, rallied four wide to close the gap on the turn and flattened out. STORMY LIL steadied in traffic and was shuffled back between horses on the turn and failed to threaten thereafter. ITEM was pinched back early, raced well back for a half, steadied along the inside nearing the quarter pole and lacked a further response. DREAM A LITTLE BIT unseated her rider and ran off briefly behind the gate, set a pressured pace into upper stretch and tired. ANDREA'S MARK failed to mount a serious rally while six wide on the turn. GLACIAL BREEZE forced the pace for five furlongs, steadied in traffic on the turn and gave way in the stretch.
