FORLI'S HONOR stalked the early pace five wide, bid at the quarter pole, drew clear in the drive then just lasted late over COMPRESSED. The latter, blocked behind the first flight for a half, angled out turning for home then finished well to just miss. DELTA DAYLIGHT, bumped at the start, fanned wide after a half then angled back in and closed a gap too late. LOVE THAT LADY dueled between rivals to the stretch before giving way. TO TO DARN SHARP lodged a mild late bid. PEPPERCORN was not a forward factor. OLD IRENE came inside after a half then was in tight and lost her action forcing the rider to check up when she shied from the inner rail. HOOPHOOPTEDOO was taken up while running up horses' heels on the backstretch, angled out then didn't gain in the drive. AHONEYOFABUNNY flashed only brief speed. ETERNAL WONDER went evenly. SUWANNEE MUSIC flashed brief foot then steadied while fading in the turn. PRINCESS ALBADOU was hard used dueling inside then weakened badly and drifted in while tiring in the drive.
