ROLLIN THE DICE made a middle move through the turn, fanned six wide into the stretch then finished well outside late. E HARNER stalked the pace inside, got through along the rail in the drive then was gaining late. MY HEART SKIPS vied three wide to the final furlong then weakened. CLIFF'S GOLD passed tiring rivals. SURVI STAR pressed four wide then gave way. PRIVATE BENJ was through after a half. SLICK JACK dueled inside to the quarter pole then came up empty. JACKIE'S PUNT showed little. FIORE DE was no factor. LUSTY KING turned in a dull effort. WHOWHATWHERE trailed.
