SYNCOPATION angled outside then lodged a mild belated bid. Z STORM stalked the pace outside to the stretch then gave way. AMY'S BUDDHA chased but gradually weakened. DR. MOHRBACHER failed to menace. SILVER TUXEDO was through early. LEADER WHIP showed little.
