PROSICO chased the early leader, took over the lead in the turn then steadily drew off through the stretch under strong handling. HAIL TO THE CAT stalked the early pace, attempted to collar the winner through the turn but couldn't stay with that one after five furlongs while best of the rest. APT TO BE made a four wide middle move then lodged a mild rally late. BELICHICK was hustled along to contention after five furlongs but failed to gain in the drive. RIGHT FLANKER showed no speed and was no factor. SUPPLY GUY raced evenly. THE WORD IS OUT was well placed to the stretch then weakened. WE HAVE A PROBLEM was through early. TYLER'S JEWEL was no factor. PEN NASR showed little. MR. WINALOT rushed to the lead, stopped after five furlongs and was being eased late.
