WHAT A LOOSECANNON stalked the pace early, bid three wide leaving the second turn then dueled through a long drive before getting up in the final strides then was vanned off after the race. SAFFRON HALL set a moderate pace, resisted the winner gamely through a long drive then just missed. SIR MURRAY was bumped into the first turn, dueled to the stretch then gave way. MARLETTE showed no speed and was not a forward factor. MANGROVE POND was well placed but had no rally. JO ANN'S BULLET raced evenly. BRUSH TO CLEAR failed to menace. LAURENS JESTER bumped SIR MURRAY into the first turn then was through after a half. NELSON AVENUE was no factor.
