Footnotes

SMOOTH WIND was reserved early, rapidly gained three wide midway on the turn, took charge in upper stretch and drew off under right hand urging. CHALLENGE PRIDE pressed the early pace outside, opened a clear lead on the turn but was no match for the winner. COOKSON raced in midpack while four wide and rallied mildly. THOMASTOWN failed to threaten while saving ground. EXPLOSIVE WONDERS showed speed while three wide to the far turn and tired. AVERY ISLAND never reached contention after bobbling at the start. KING MONGO was used up setting the early pace. WHIP THE GROOM was finished early.
