COMPROMISE raced tucked in for seven furlongs, angled out four wide into the stretch then quickly disposed of the leaders through the furlong grounds and drew off with a flourish. CENTER DIVIDER made a three wide middle move to contention but was no match for the winner while outfinishing the rest for the place. CAT PARK made a middle move in traffic then made up some ground inside late. BUCHERON passed tiring rivals. MY BOY JO pressed the pace three wide, gained a short lead into the stretch but gave way in the final furlong. VALTRUS vied for the lead for seven furlongs then faded. TAXES FOR BEN set a moderate pace to upper stretch then weakened. FORTISSI MORE failed to menace.
