R BETTY GRAYBULL was blocked in traffic through the turn, advanced inside into the stretch, split rivals leaving the furlong marker to challenge then was up in the final strides. PAY THE MAN was never far back, bid into the stretch inside, angled off the rail to gain the lead leaving the furlong marker only to be caught late while second best. AZURA made a three wide middle move, bid outside into the stretch to be in striking distance then weakened. D DAY passed tiring rivals. SASSY CITY rushed to the front early, set a fast pace past mid stretch then faltered. EXCLUSIVE WOMAN was well placed to the quarter pole then faded. MAYOMAST was through after a half. STAR OPERATOR showed little.
