SILVER TRINKET chased the leader for more than six furlongs, bid out of the second turn then edged clear leaving the furlong grounds and prevailed under pressure. DRUMSTICKS set a moderate to slow pace, resisted the winner to mid stretch then hung while saving the place. ACROSS THE CREEK stalked inside for more than six furlongs, angled outside for the drive then gained some ground late. TIME TO JAZZ was forwardly placed throughout but failed to respond in the drive. WHAT A SWEEP made a middle move to the stretch then came up empty. HALO'S GLOW was well placed for five furlongs then faded. MISS SHOWER was well placed but had no rally. SISTERS BLACKHAWK raced evenly. GEBB'S PRINCESS showed little. SO WONDERFUL trailed. The portable inner rail was set out 22 feet.
