ART FAIR was well placed for six furlongs then gave way. DOC'S HONEY passed tiring rivals. SHOOT FOR THE LOOT dueled inside to the stretch then came up empty. P. J.'S ESKIMO showed little. PAR GOLFER was through after a half.
