ROCK CANDY was never far back, bid three wide leaving the second turn then ran down AMERIBELLE in the final strides. AMERIBELLE stalked the pace inside, angled off the rail to challenge for and gain a clear lead in upper stretch then continued well to late before just hanging. DON'T FORGET GIL broke through the gate pre start, was rated along early, made a middle move through the second turn then swung five wide in the drive and closed well to also just miss. DZIBANCHE also broke through the gate pre start, set a moderate pace inside then steadied into the stretch while tiring. BRINCA passed tiring rivals. UNO PESO failed to menace. COFFEE IN BED checked over heels into the first turn before rushing up to contest the pace then came up empty after five furlongs. SWEET REPENT showed little.
