O T B BOB allowed to settle, looped up four wide through the turn, fanned widest into the stretch, then made a steady gain and drew off under mild urging. ROCK ALEX sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, increased his margin while never being challenged, then was no match for the winner in the lane, while clearly best of the rest. BOLD CAPTAIN well placed and outside, moved up three and four wide through the turn, bid three wide into the stretch and could not gain. RICO SUAVE rated close up pulling, came through inside of rivals into the stretch and evened out. COUNTRY LYRIC pulled to contention quickly, gained a striking position on the two path through the second turn, bid between rivals into the stretch and weakened in the drive. CHASING THE ROSES showed little. PLAYING A JOKE bumped and stumbled badly at the start, was no factor.
