STAR REWARD bumped with VICTORIA'S CAFE at the break, stalked the pace inside, was forced to wait through the second turn for racing room then found room along the rail to challenge into the furlong grounds and quickly moved away late while ridden out. SET FREE TO FLY raced close up early, bid three wide to gain a short lead into the stretch but was no match for the winner while saving the place. SHOWMETHEOCEAN raced close up, bid four wide out of the second turn then drifted a bit wide in the drive while weakening. JIMMY'S TOO BLUE stalked inside, got through along the rail to challenge for and gain a short lead in the second turn then gave way in the final furlong. MISS MULLIGAN raced evenly. PRIMA DEA was hung six wide to the second turn. LADY HARRIET was hung seven wide. VICTORIA'S CAFE was bumped at the break, lead early then stopped. SUNDAY CRUISIN' was through early.
