EXPECTED TEMPER chased the early leader for five furlongs, bid out of the turn to gain the lead then after drawing off to mid stretch, was kept to pressure to prove best. DEBS LI'L ESCAPADE made a four wide middle move and was best of the rest. PER DIEM advanced to mid stretch then weakened. RIVA'S AFFAIR made a middle move but failed to sustain that rally. LET'S TWIST rushed to the front from the outside but had little left after five furlongs. THAT'S OUR DAISY passed tiring rivals. NOBLE KITTEN raced evenly. SERBIA was through after a half. SAM'S FOUNTAIN chased to the turn then faded. QUEENS MONEY showed little.
