BEST WESTERNER bore out early, made a three wide move to contention then fanned four wide into the stretch before rallying past the leaders leaving the furlong marker. WILD 'N' WAKI GUY chased inside, angled off the rail to go after the leader leaving the second turn then after gaining a short lead a furlong out, hung late. QUISTOPHER rushed to the front early, set a solid pace then resisted to late before hanging. BEIJING HOUSE made an inside middle move then was outkicked late. FLYMAMBO passed tiring foes. PRIVY SEAL (IRE) got through inside in the drive but failed to gain. MAKAAAN chased early, bid leaving the second turn then flattened out. CHIEF THIEF failed to menace. J T KINGFISHER showed little. LUCKY LEO stopped.
