CERTAIN APPEAL looped rivals four wide, challenged the leaders into the stretch then shook clear late under pressure. HOV LANE raced close up early, moved to the lead into the second turn then resisted the winner to late before weakening while second best. DANCE TO THE ROAR made a middle move to the stretch but failed to sustain that rally. LITTLE JAKE was well placed but had no rally. DABOSSMAN was no factor. LET IT BE HARDYBOY was through after a half. L. G.'S FLASH disputed the pace early then faded. BLACKEYE WYNN was used up. CORONADO CHARLIE showed little. TIME TIX AHEAD stopped. A claim of foul by the rider of TIME TIX AHEAD against DANCE TO THE ROAR for interference into the second turn was disallowed.
