WITH OPTIONS stalked the pace early, bid four wide after a half then was up late after a long drive. ST. PAT'S CAT chased early, bid three wide into the stretch then also dueled to late but was outkicked. CATCHUPDOUBLEUP was void of early speed, angled out six wide for the drive then finished well late. MONEYSTITETONIGHT pressed for a half then gave way. IRISH DOUBLE dueled past mid stretch before weakening then pulled up in distress and was vanned off. TRUE GLORY dueled for a half then faded. PHANTASTIC JET raced evenly. MARCO FLYER was no factor. GAVAN'S REPENT checked at the break then again approaching the turn. HEZANELITE was no factor. KNIGHT WONDER stopped.
