CRASH IN BOSTON stalked the pace early, bid four wide out of the second turn then rallied past the leaders to win going away. WIRELESS MACHO made an inside middle move, steadied and altered course outside for racing room in upper stretch then was up for the place late. L. G.'S FLASH chased early, bid into the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. LIONOFWALLSTREET set a fast pace early then gave way in the drive. K'S CLASSIC SMILE raced evenly. TIP OF THE LAKE also raced evenly. DOUBLE DOWN BROWN broke slow. WILL RUN FOR BEER was through after a half. TURN TO MILLER was no factor.
