JANIE B chased the leader from the outset, made one move outside that one leaving the turn, held on well when that one regained a clear lead then ran her down late under strong handling. CHATTIN CAT sprinted clear early, repulsed one bid leaving the turn to regain a clear lead in the stretch but just failed to last while besting the rest. L'S LIGHTNING chased outside, bid three wide passing the quarter pole then weakened in the drive. FLORIDA QUAKER came in to bump and push BRIGHT TOMORROW to the inside in the drive. NOEMOTION was well placed but had no rally. HOLLY LAND passed tiring rivals. BRIGHT TOMORROWS was bumped and pushed in during the drive then lacked racing room thereafter. CUT FOR LUCK was no factor. SHE'S DUE FOR ONE chased to the stretch then faded. PRIVATE SEA was through early then was in tight while tiring in the stretch. Following a stewards inquiry FLORIDA QUAKER was disqualified and placed seventh for interference in the stretch.
