TUCKERED saved ground much of the way, waited for an opening through the second turn and into the stretch then split horses in the furlong grounds and drew off smartly late while ridden out. DYNAMIC FEATURE was void of early speed, fanned five wide into the stretch then rallied late to be up for the place. PRIVATE RUTHIE saved ground early, was blocked from the quarter pole to mid stretch then angled outside and closed ground but too late. ULTRA PREVENTION made a three wide middle move to challenge after five furlongs, held a short lead in the drive then weakened. FIVE ALARM BLAZE chased early, bid after five furlongs then flattened out. LAST CHANCE GULCH challenged through the second turn then gave way. BUMP IS SWEET held a long early lead then came up empty. GEBB'S CHEQUER was no factdor. LA CORUNA showed little.
