GLIDE OVER PYRITE raced close up early, bid four wide through the turn, was headed in the furlong grounds then came back on again late to edge clear. LAWYER GEORGE was blocked behind rivals leaving the turn, angled out five wide for racing room then was slowly gaining late outside. WEST TEXAS dueled inside, was headed into the stretch, came back on again through the furlong grounds before hanging late. FURKA PASS chased early, bid through the turn then weakened in the final furlong. EGERTON passed tiring rivals. BARCO was through after a half. MASTER'S BIG BOY showed little. HERE TO PLEASE was no factor.
