This field will be limited to twelve starters. In the event more than twelve entries pass through the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined with preference given to those with highest career earnings. In addition, no same owner entry may start, regardless of earnings, to the exclusion of a single entry.

JUST BILL ME chased the early leader, bid into the second turn, drew off to mid stretch then held CRIMSON AND ROSES safe under steady handling. CRIMSON AND ROSES stalked the leaders for more than six furlongs, rallied three wide out of the second turn then was slowly getting to the winner late. DAKOTA LIGHT bore in at the break impeding NONOUR and forcing that one into the inner rail, was unhurried to the stretch then was gaining some ground inside through the late stages. YACHT CLUB stalked the pace inside, was blocked briefly behind a tiring rival passing the quarter pole but failed to respond when swung outside. MARY MURPHY set the pace for three quarters then gave way. ARCTIC DOVE was no factor. SPLASHA was well placed for six furlongs but came up empty. NONOUR was forced to the inside and hit the inside rail at the break then trailed.
