BACK AWAY stalked the pace early, bid three wide to challenge of the second turn while drifting wide then pulled away late once straightened. CAPTAIN NIGHTCAP raced erratic in the first turn, recovered to make a middle move to contention then bested the rest outside. POLITICAL RACE pressed the pace from the outset, bid in the second turn then slowly weakened in the drive. SCHOOL BOY HEART set a moderate pace to near mid stretch then gave way. UNGUIDED MISSILE was no factor. AUTHORIZED AGENT showed little. SERVICE DUTY HONOR raced wide early and was no factor. RACE TIMES WERE PROVIDED BY TRAKUS
