IOYA TWO was unhurried early, made an inside middle move through the second turn, angled out five wide for the drive then ran past the leaders with a flourish leaving the furlong marker and won going away while ridden out. SUMMERHILL GAL also advanced inside through the second turn, posed a threat outside LIGHT THE RIVER in the furlong grounds but was no match for the winner while besting the rest for the place. LIGHT THE RIVER chased the early leaders, split rivals to gain the lead on the backstretch, drew clear after five furlongs but weakened in the final furlong. BARE LEGS was well placed but failed to respond in the drive. DEE O sprinted clear early, dueled then gave way. SWEET SINGING SAMI failed to menace. SEVEN BLUES BABY was through after a half. BARBS KIPPER was no factor. PARIENTE BARBARA stopped. The portable inner rail was set out 22 feet.
