Footnotes

COSMONAUT chased the early leader, took over command in the second turn, turned back a bid from BALLONENOSTRIKES through the furlong grounds when roused left handed then proved best under steady handling. BALLONENOSTRIKES was never far back, bid outside the winner into the stretch to loom a threat a furlong out but hung late while besting the rest. SOLDIER'S DANCER was void of early speed, fanned six wide into the stretch then was gaining along the far outside late. CLASSIC CAMPAIGN was well placed into the stretch but lacked a strong late response. ARCHERS ALYANCER set a slow pace early then slowly weakened. STAY CLOSE (GB) steadied in tight quarters into the first turn. ICY ATLANTIC was well placed but had no rally. BIG PRAIRIE raced evenly. MYSTERIOUS PEINTRE (FR) was no factor. PUPPETEER (GB) stopped.
