SWEETEN WITH GOLD waited inside in the turn for racing room, angled off the rail to go after the leader into the stretch then disposed of that one leaving the furlong marker to win going away. GALLANT LOVER dueled for the lead to mid stretch, was no match for the winner but was easily second best. BAND OF THUNDER looped six wide advancing to the stretch but failed to sustain that rally. LIVE THE DASH vied for the lead to the quarter pole then weakened. SWIFT STRIKE failed to menace. FLY SO FAST vied early then gave way. SARATOGA STORM pressed the pace four wide then came up empty. DANCE WITH ROSES stopped.
