GOLF PAL raced close up early, slipped through along the inside to challenge for and gain the lead after five furlongs then prevailed late after a long drive. BIBLIONICO bid three wide in the turn, couldn't reach the winner but saved the place late. MAD MECKE also got through along the inside in the turn to move to contention, angled to the middle of the track in upper stretch but lacked a strong late response. ESPRESSO DOBLE closed a gap but too late. MY IMPERIAL DANCER weakened gradually. PRINCE DAVID failed to meance. BIG ROYAL ELTISH was through after a half. PROMENADES HERO broke slow. MISTER MERZ dueled early then faded. WHISKEYONTHEROCKS was no factor.
