FOREVER WILD was allowed to settle early, fanned five wide out of the second turn while advancing then rallied past the leader and outfinished TAMPA'S BIG CITY late. TAMPA'S BIG CITY raced boxed inside through the second turn, angled off the rail to go after the leader out of the second turn then rallied in company with the winner late but was outfinished while up for the place. SHOOT OUT chased the early leader, bid leaving the second turn to gain the lead, drew off to mid stretch then hung late. WAYZATA BAY passed tiring rivals. DESERT SAKER also passed faders. LIVELY EXIT was rushed to the lead early then had little left after six furlongs. DR. HOCKING failed to menace. DAN'S SOLDIER was hung four wide stalking the pace, bid through the second turn then faltered. MISSILE CONTROL was through early.
