CABBAGE KEY made a middle move inside, split rivals into the stretch while coming out slightly then finished strong to rally past the leader leaving the furlong marker and be along in time. CRAZY COUSIN set a moderate pace, held a clear lead into the stretch but was no match for the winner's challenge while saving the place. NOTACHARLIE'SANGEL saved ground to the stretch, angled off the rail but lacked a late response. LEMON DROP GIRL chased for six furlongs then gave way. LADY ELIZABETH was taken up early. SEEING CLEARLY showed little. BOROBETA was no factor. GENESIS chased, came up empty then was pushed out slightly into the stretch by the winner. GOTTA LUV CARROTS was through after a half. A claim of foul by the rider of Genesis against the winner for interference into the stretch was disallowed.
