OYSTER fanned four wide out of the turn to challenge but couldn't stay with the winner while easily second best. FIORE DICAMPO lodged a mild rally late. LET THE BELLS RING dueled to the quarter pole then weakened. DEVIL'S WEEKEND raced evenly. PRESTO CASH dueled early then faded. SMOKEY PRADO showed little. LITTLE B P was through after a half. REPENT AND REJOICE had his rider attempting to balance himself at the break and unseated same. There was a stewards inquiry conducted into the start before the results were declared official.
